Do I need special software to use the library's digital ebooks with my eReader?

Adobe Digital Editions: This software is required to download, read and transfer Adobe eBooks from your computer to a compatible eReader.

OverDrive App: A free app from OverDrive that is available for your iPhone, iPad, iTouch or Android enable device that allows you to select, download and read Adobe eBooks on your eReader.

Bluefire App: This free app works with Adobe eBooks from OverDrive on your iPad.

Mobipocket Reader: This software is required to download, read and transfer Mobipocket eBooks from OverDrive. You can download the free software for your PC or mobile device at

Why do I need an Adobe Digital Editions ID? Adobe Digital Editions is required to download, read and transfer Adobe ebooks from your computer to most eReader devices. If you choose Anonymous activation allows you to download and read DRM-protected eBooks on a *single computer only*. Activating using an Adobe ID allows you to download and read DRM-protected eBooks on *multiple computers* and transfer them to supported eBook devices.

Overdrive E-Book Basics (including Adobe Digital Editions, public domain eBooks, and transferring to a Sony or Nook eReader). Overdrive Checkout Period: choice of 7 & 14. Checkout limit: 15 titles at once, with option to return early.

How do I get started?

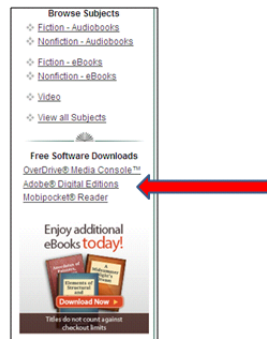
1. Charge the Reader via USB at least 40 minutes until, "USB connected," appears on the Reader's screen. To download eBooks/audiobooks to your eReader you will need to install the following free software to your
 - a. PC (Windows XP or newer)
 - eBook Library (Sony software) or the software that the manufacture provided with your eReader
 - Adobe Digital Editions
 - b. Mac Computer (OS 10.4.9 or newer) with an Intel or PowerPC processor
 - Setup eBook library
 - Adobe Digital Editions

Step 1: Download and install free software

1. Go to <http://nsdc.lib.overdrive.com/>



2. Click on the link on the bottom left-hand side, "Adobe Digital Editions" or go to <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/>

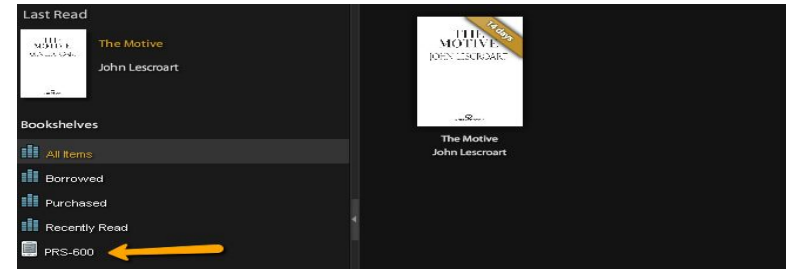


Software for E-Books

1. When downloading Adobe Digital Editions

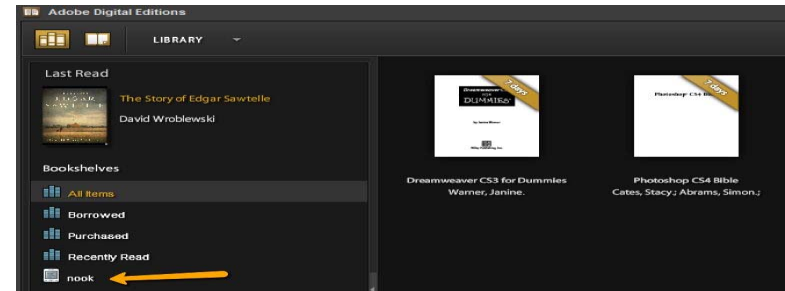
12. Click on the Adobe eBook you want to transfer.
13. Drag the Adobe eBook to the eBook device icon in the left pane of Adobe Digital Editions. The 'Copy Documents' dialog box is displayed and the title is transferred.

Here is an example of how a Sony Reader appears:



*Sony eBook Library software must be installed on your computer to transfer Adobe eBooks to the Sony Reader.

Here is an example of how a Nook appears:

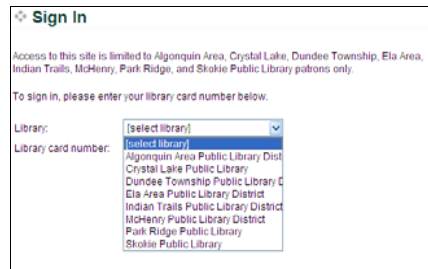


14. When transfer is complete the 'Copy Documents' dialog box closes. Disconnect the eBook device and enjoy.

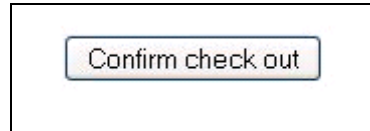
Note: All titles will automatically check-in and be removed from your library account after the time you've selected has run out.

* You are able to download an Adobe eBook on up to 6 computers/ devices that have been activated with the *same* Adobe ID.

6. To check out, enter your library card number and select your home library from the dropdown menu

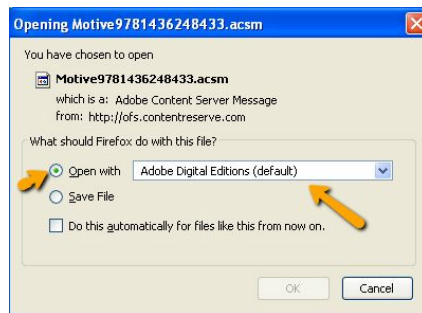


7. Choose the duration of your checkout (7 or 14 days) and “Confirm Checkout”



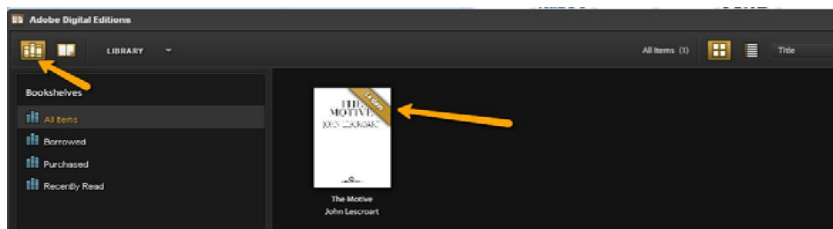
8. Select “Download”

9. Select ‘Open with’ and ‘Adobe Digital Editions’ on the dialog box that pops up. Do not save file.



10. Adobe Digital Editions will open and your book will appear in the library.

11. In Adobe Digital Editions, select the 'Library View' icon (in the upper left corner). The Adobe Digital Editions library is displayed.



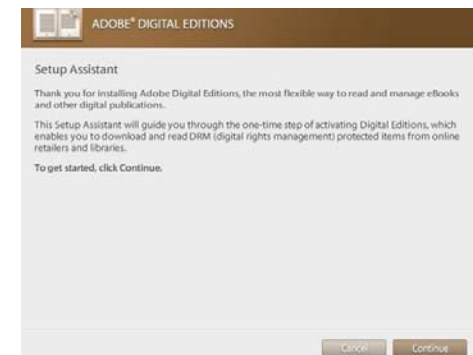
(used for eBooks), in the new window, choose “Download Now” (on right-hand side).



2. Scroll down and then select the “Launch” button



3. The following screen will appear and Click “Continue”

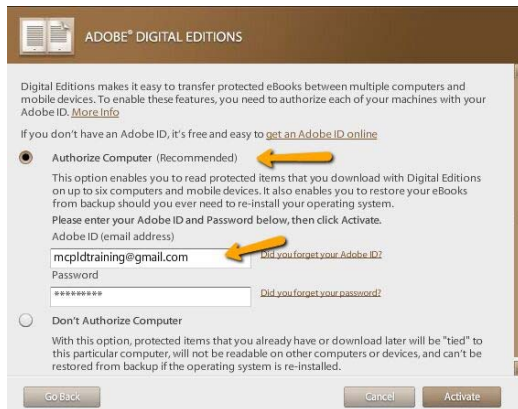


4. Click, “Get an Adobe ID

online (indicated by arrow). This will launch your web browser, and redirect you to the Adobe web page where you can create an Adobe ID.



5. After creating your Adobe Digital Editions ID, log in (as seen below) using your username and password. Make sure you also select (if not already), “Authorize Computer”.

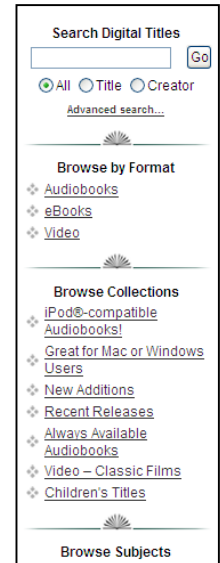


6. Click the “Activate” button (if you ever wish to

de-authorize your Adobe Digital Editions, you can do so by holding down Control, Shift and D.)

Step 2: Checkout and Download

1. Turn your Reader on. Note: If the Reader does not turn on, the battery has been fully depleted. Connect the Reader to your computer using the USB cable.
2. From the Overdrive menu (<http://nsdc.lib.overdrive.com/>), choose to “Browse by Format,” “Browse Collections,” “Browse Subjects,” or Search Digital Titles.
3. To download an eBook to your device, you must choose ePub or PDF format
4. Select an available title and “Add to Bookbag.”



Then, continue browsing for more titles or, if you are finished choose, “Proceed to



Checkout”.



5. If the title is not currently available, you may “Place a hold,” and you will be notified via email when the title becomes available.
