## **Official Rules:**

Entries will be accepted in three categories: **Tween** (grades 4-8), **Teen** (grades 9-12), and **Adult** (ages 18+).

**The contest is open to all amateur artists.** Amateur in this case is defined as earning less than a maximum of \$2,000 annually from artistic work.

Submissions will be accepted at the MPLD Questions Desk from **September 1** to **September 30**, **2020**. You can also email your submission to **mplyps@mchenrylibrary.org** with the subject "Let's Make History Art Contest."

The artist's name, age/grade, phone number, and name of school (if applicable) must be included at the time of submission. **No personal information may be visible on the artwork.** 

Each participant may submit one (1) piece of original artwork into the contest.

Artwork must be the original work of the participant without help from others.

Any kind of art may be submitted, including, but not limited to, paintings, drawings, prints, computer generated art, photographs, mixed media, or sculpture.

Guidelines for drawings, paintings, and other kinds of 2-Dimensional artwork (Computer generated art must meet these requirements when printed):

- May be no larger than 11 inches by 17 inches
- Must be on **UNLINED** paper
- If turning in at the Questions Desk, please enclose your submission in either a manila envelope or ziplock bag

Winners will be selected by popular vote during ComiCon Week on **October 18 - 24, 2020**. Voting will occur online at **mchenrylibrary.org**.

Winners in each category will be notified by October 31, 2020

- First place will receive drawing supplies and a \$20 Michaels gift certificate
- Second place will receive drawing supplies and a \$15 Michaels gift certificate
- Third place will receive drawing supplies and a \$10 Michaels gift certificate

"Staff Choice" Award: One additional winner in each category will be chosen by McHenry Public Library staff and will receive a \$15 Michaels gift certificate.

If any of these rules are not followed, the artwork will not be considered for the contest.
