Official Rules:

- Participants must be in 4th to 8th grade.
- Submissions will be accepted at the Questions Desk from September 11 to October 8.
- Each participant may submit one (1) piece of original artwork into the contest.
- Artwork must be the original work of the participant without help from others.
- Any kind of art maybe submitted, including, but not limited to paintings, drawings, prints, computer generated art, photographs, mixed media, or sculpture.

Guidelines for drawings, paintings, and other kinds of 2-Dimensional artwork (Computer generated art must meet these requirements when printed):

- May be no larger than 11 inches by 17 inches
- Must be on UNLINED paper
- Must be able to be mounted flat on the wall

Guidelines for sculpture and other 3-Dimentional artwork:

- May be no larger than 10 inches tall, 10 inches deep, and 16 inches wide.
- The artist's name, grade, phone number, and name of school will be collected at the time of submission and placed on the BACK or the BOTTOM of the artwork. No personal information may be visible on the artwork.
- Digital submission for computer generated art and photographs may be sent to mplyps@mchenrylibrary.org with the subject "Set the Scene Art Contest." The artist's name, grade, phone number, and name of school must be included in the email with the digital submission.
- Entries will be placed in two categories, 4^{th} through 5^{th} grade or 6^{th} through 8^{th} grade.
- Winners will selected by popular vote during ComiCon on October 12.
- Winners will be notified October 14.
 - First place will receive drawing supplies and a \$20 Michaels gift certificate
 - Second place will receive drawing supplies and a \$15 Michaels gift certificate
 - Third place will receive drawing supplies and a \$10 Michaels gift certificate

If any of these rules are not followed, the artwork will not be considered for the contest.
